

## MASAI STEERING GUARD ILLUSTRATED FITTING MANUAL



## You will need:

- General workshop tools
- Torx wrench (Optional)
- Penetrating oil (Optional)



1. Remove the highlighted nuts from your vehicle in order to attach the left hand side bracket to the chassis.



3. Repeat the process with the right hand bracket as shown above.



5. The brackets should fit to the rear of the steering guard as shown above.



2. You may need to use a suitable penetrating oil to remove the nuts. If they are not present, use the nuts provided with the kit instead.



4. Adjust the distance between the left and right hand brackets to fit the holes on the back of the steering guard.



6. Fasten the outermost bolts using a spanner or a torx wrench.





7. Finally, fasten the innermost bolts using a spanner or a torx wrench. You can use an appropriate adhesive on the bolts to keep them in place, but this step isn't essential. The installation is now complete!
