

TUBULAR ROOF RACK

ILLUSTRATED FITTING MANUAL



You will need:

- General workshop tools
- Step ladders
- A friend to help you lift the roof rack

TUBULAR ROOF RACK

Thank you for purchasing the Masai Tubular Roof Rack. Please read these instructions carefully before commencing work.

Make sure you have all the tools and other equipment ready before you start, including a table near your vehicle. Please follow widely accepted safety precautions.

Your kit includes:

- Roof rack framework
- 6 horizontal crossbars
- Leg brackets—1 per leg
- Nuts
- Bolts
- Washers
- Rubber pads



1. For each leg, prepare the parts needed to assemble the leg brackets.




2. Fix the protective rubber strip to the base of each leg. This will protect the metal while it is on your vehicle and while you assemble the roof rack.



3. Insert the bolt as shown in the image above and apply the strip of protective rubber to the rear side of the bracket. This will be used to fit the legs to the guttering.



4. Using a nut, bolt and two washers for each bracket - as shown in the image - assemble the horizontal support beams on the front of the roof rack. If your vehicle has a sunroof then you can choose to leave these bars out.



5. Ensure each bolt is fastened tightly, as this part of the roof rack will be taking the weight of a load.



6. Connect the sections of framework together as shown using the ribbed rubber bungs provided. Before you insert the bungs, coat them in silicon (provided) to prevent any leakage. Use a rubber mallet to tap the pipes together as they are a tight fit.



7. Fasten a bolt through the bracket to hold the sections together.



8. Your roof rack should now be fully assembled, and look something like this, with either all or none of the front bars fitted depending on your preference.




9. Using these brackets, fit each leg to the guttering of your Defender.



10. The brackets fit around the outside of the guttering and the legs slot inside the gutter itself. Ensure that the bolts are firmly tightened.
